Scientists and governments everywhere believe that COVID-19 is the most serious and dangerous virus to emerge in many years. From the end of 2019 until now, it has caused many infections around the world and many people have died. People have lost their jobs and sources of income because businesses have been terribly affected. At the start of the pandemic, there were not enough masks to wear which caused many problems in Hong Kong and other places. The pandemic also caused problems for many hospitals around the world as they had too many patients and not enough hospital beds.

The best advice we have from scientists and doctors is to stay at home as much as we can, avoid crowds and keep our environments clean. Vaccines are urgently needed around the world to help bring the virus under control.

COVID-19 Vaccines

Nowadays, there are three vaccines that have emerged in different countries and are available in Hong Kong, or will hopefully be available soon. They are BioNTech, AstraZeneca and Sinovac.

First, there is BioNTech from Germany. The German company BioNTech is the initial developer of the vaccine. The American company Pfizer supports BioNTech with the clinical trials, logistics and manufacturing. A study revealed a potential efficacy of nearly 95% in preventing infection within seven days of a second dose. Another vaccine is from Sinovac Biotech, a Chinese biopharmaceutical company. Their research showed an efficacy of up to 83.5% in preventing infection. Both BioNTech and Sinovac are available to get in Hong Kong now. Older people and health workers at high risk of exposure will get these vaccines first. People can register and make reservations online.

A third vaccine is from AstraZeneca, a British-Swedish multinational pharmaceutical and biotechnology company. It is not available to get this vaccine in Hong Kong at present. People cannot sign up online now, but may be able to do so in future. It is found that the vaccine had an efficacy of 82.4 percent when two doses were given 12 weeks apart.

These vaccines can reduce opportunities for the virus to spread. It also teaches our bodies to fight the infection from the pandemic. I hope with these and other vaccines that COVID-19 can be stopped in the

world.

What is a piano?

The piano is a musical instrument. A person who plays the piano is called a pianist. The piano was invented by Bartolomeo Cristofori of Padua, Italy. He made his first piano in 1709. It developed from the clavichord which looks like a piano, but the strings of a clavichord are hit by a small blade of metal called a "tangent". In the piano the strings are hit by a block of wood called a hammer. The early keyboarded instruments, such as the clavichords, harpsichord and organs that were used at that time, had a much shorter keyboard than they do today. Gradually the keyboard became longer until it had the 88 notes (7 octaves plus three notes) of the modern piano.

My experience of piano

I have played piano for 8 years. I'm good at playing pop music and classical music. Practice is the most important thing in learning piano. I keep playing piano 1-3 hours a day. Sometimes I play it for 5 hours. I think it's a hard thing to sit on the chair for a long time! My favourite thing about piano is performing on the stage.
