In July, there were cases of COVID-19 in Choi Hung. It was discovered that the chef in a local restaurant and some of the restaurant's staff had COVID-19. Moreover, three customers who visited the restaurant also showed symptoms of COVID-19. A taxi driver also emerged with signs of COVID-19 on the 12th of July. Two primary school students were also infected with COVID-19.

The Department of Health delivered some sample bottles for people in the estate so they could be tested. Due to all of this, we had to become very careful and aware of the dangers of COVID-19. 
Coronavirus in October 2020




Dog Man - Brawl of the Wild




